J-Squared supports the goals and objectives of the 2010 Dodd-Frank Act. This Act seeks to end conflict and human suffering associated with the illegal mining and trafficking of “Conflict Minerals” tantalum, tin, tungsten and gold, in the Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC) and surrounding areas (Sudan, Uganda, Rwanda, Burundi, Tanzania, Zambia, Angola, Congo, and the Central African Republic). J-Squared has monitored these developments as they impact the electronics supply chain and is committed to helping our customers comply with all reporting requirements.

As a distributor of electronics components J-Squared does not directly purchase any conflict materials from any source nor knowingly procure any products that contain “Conflict Minerals”. Electronic manufacturers understand that their distributors are not authorized to provide this level of detail to the end customer. J-Squared realizes the importance of the 2010 Dodd-Frank Act and fully supports its objectives. We are committed to working with our suppliers to increase the transparency regarding the origin and traceability of the minerals contained in their products.
